Supply list

PLEASE NOTE: CE courses are held contingent on a minimum enrollment, which is determined three business days prior to a class start date. As a class may be cancelled, we recommend that you **do not open or use your materials until at least two days prior to your class start date.** This way you are free to return your merchandise without problem. Students will be contacted only if there is a class cancellation or a change.

All supplies may be purchased at the KCAI Art Store unless otherwise indicated.

Students will be making their own permanent Thermofax printing screens during the class. They will be of the student's own design and must be purchased during the class. Students should plan on spending about \$25 to \$35 on screens that cost between \$5 and \$15 each.

At some time near the mid point of classes students will also use a small amount of Disperse Dyes that I will have on hand to purchase. This will cost no more than \$5 per person for all the disperse dye they will need.

GENERAL SUPPLIES (all of the supplies in this category may be items already on hand, used, or purchased from a thrift store)

- **4 ounce plastic cups with lids**
- clear or white **measuring spoons** (1/8 t to 1 T size)
- clear or white **measuring cups** (1/8 c to 1 c size)
- **stir sticks** and **small spatulas**
- plastic **gloves**
- plastic **apron**
- **2 or 3 watercolor type paint brushes** (one each sm, md, lg)
- white copy **paper**, butcher paper, or any common paper that won't absorb paint
- Old **newspapers**, old bath towel, **cloths** or **rags**, and **paper towels**
- **Black marker**
- **Pencils**
- **Copy paper and sketch book**

DYE SUPPLIES and FABRIC

- **Squeegees** (Pack of 3 "Bondo" spreaders from Walmart in automotive dept. or car supply store)
- **Thermofax screens** (made and purchased in class)
- **Scissors**
- **T pins** (from fabric store or Hammer Brothers (816) 842-7290 - 407 Grand Blvd)
- Jacquard **Fabric Paints** (Lumiere) - 4 or 5 different of colors
OR [preferred] Pro Chem **Fabric Paints** - 4 or 5 colors

FABRICS

- **Polyester Fabrics** white or beige **100%** polyester or nylon **fabrics** in different weights.
- **Silk Fabric** Organza, habotai, crepe de chine, chiffon
- **Cotton Fabric** broadcloth, organza, and regular weight cotton fabric
- **Tee shirts** (any sizes, as many as the student would like to print **I will have several on hand to purchase**)
