

The Kansas City Art Institute has prepared this campus hazing transparency report in order to maintain compliance with the Stop Campus Hazing Act. The college has a hazing policy, which can be found here. KCAI's policy is based on the definition of hazing as defined by Missouri law and contains information about the definition of hazing, as well as procedures for reporting and resolution. Allegations of hazing may be reported to Student Affairs staff members, and/or members of the Safety and Security Team. All reports alleging hazing will be reviewed and investigated according to the KCAI student code of conduct procedures. The KCAI student code of conduct, including procedures, can be found here. The hazing policy and student code of conduct are available in the KCAI policy library. In addition to these resources being available online, KCAI also provides training and information about hazing during new student orientation, Title IX/Sexual Harassment training, and through Student Activities via Student Organizations.

During the 2024-2025 academic year, KCAI received zero reports alleging hazing. This includes situations on and off campus that would have involved any members of the KCAI campus community. Records for this reporting are tracked by Student Affairs staff members in conjunction and collaboration with Safety and Security staff members. This report reflects updates as of July 2025.
